## Observations, Science and Technology Recommendations

- 1. Promote open data archives and data sharing for the partners in WEFN studies
- 2. A project should be launched to evaluate the potential of citizen science to inform some integrated aspect of the WEF in a critical region during a critical period of the year.
- 3. Pilot projects should be undertaken to assess possible indicators for the WEF Nexus. Based on these pilot projects a suite of indicators should be produced on a regular basis.
- 4. A study of the potential role of a risk management framework in managing the WEFN should be undertaken
- 5. A plan for an information platform featuring water, land, energy, food. Ecosystems (including forestry) and socio-economic data
- 6. A pilot project on the use of citizen data should be undertaken that include collection of the data, use of the data by WEFN stakeholders, and integration of the data with conventional data.

## Broader Recommendations

Conduct an in-depth analysis of the WEFN to clarify the needs of stakeholders and how the needs can best be met.
